



Check if your little "time" or mini-story illustrates something about you.



Does your mini-story serve as an example of one of your defining qualities, characteristics or core values?










STEP TWO: Describe what you *learned*from that mini-story.






Open up.








STEP THREE: Explain why what you learned matters.






Explain why it matters that you value integrity, or social justice or a musical ear.







